

COSMETOLOGY COURSE OBJECTIVES

The Summit Salon Academy's objective for the cosmetology course/ program includes theory and practical teaching that prepares the student to perform hair, skin, and nail services on the general public. The Academy offers an 1800-hour training course/ program in the cosmetology arts and sciences that meets Washington state standards.

The Academy provides education in all phases of cosmetology. The graduate will have knowledge in the business skills of today's industry as well as the theory and practical skills required by Washington state laws. The graduate will have the background and skills to pass the state board-licensing exam and to work as a cosmetologist. Career paths for a Cosmetologist may be stylist, salon manager, salon owner, distributor sales consultant, platform artist and more.
