

ESTHETICS COURSE OBJECTIVES

Esthetics training at the Academy includes theory, practical instruction, and business-building skills which prepare the student to perform skin care and make up services (esthetics) on the general public. The Academy offers a 750-hour training course/ program that meets Washington state law standards.

The Academy provides education in all phases of esthetics. The graduate will have knowledge in the business skills of today's industry as well as the theory and practical skills required by Washington state laws. The graduate will have the background and skills to pass the state board-licensing exam and to work as an esthetician. Career paths for an Esthetician may be esthetician, makeup artist, spa manager, salon/spa owner, distributor sales consultant and more.
